KEY MESSAGES

HIV-induced peripheral neuropathies are relatively prevalent among the population of persons living with HIV

Peripheral neuropathies of other infectious agent etiologies are also relatively prevalent

Treatment is primarily centered on eliminating the disease-causing agent; neuropathies caused by infectious agents lacking treatments are also untreatable



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
